JACKPOT ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES

THURSDAY, February 8, 2024

6:30 P.M. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting of the Jackpot Advisory Board was called to order by Jackpot Advisory Board member Jeff Young at 6:35 pm mountain standard time on February 8, 2024, in the meeting room of the Jackpot Administration Building, Jackpot, Nevada.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE GALLERY:

Jackpot Advisory Board member Jeff Young advised the public to step to the front of the room to identify themselves and to speak clearly for the record. **RAFT RIVER RURAL ELECTRIC COMPANY

Raft River Electric update.

Mike Christensen (Raft River Electric) stated that they had no power issues or were aware of any. He mentioned that the educational grant scholarship for high school seniors will be due March 12th. The criteria to apply for the scholarship is that they are members, or the guardians need to have a membership with Raft River Electric. There will be five names drawn for two thousand dollars educational grants. It's a lottery style drawing. Those names that are drawn will be eligible to use the funds for three years. He knows that there was a student from Jackpot last year whose name was drawn, but he hasn't used the funds. If he decides to go to school in the next two years it can be used. The drawing will be March 19th at Raft River annual meeting. The registration starts at 6pm and at 7pm the business meeting will start. There are two contestant elections for board members this year in District 2 and District 4. Jackpot is represented in District 4. The contestants for District 4 are Susan Nye from Jarbidge and Shawn Burt from Jackpot. The contestants for District 2 are Sherrie Erickson and Kay Hill. The mail in ballots will be sent in the week of the 12th or people can do in-person voting the night of the meeting.

Jeff Young (Jackpot Advisory Board member) stated that everything has operated smoothly with no power outages.

The Town Clerk asked where the students needed to look for the scholarship application. Mr. Christensen stated that they could go on the Raft River Electric website, News and our Community tab, and that should have the scholarship information. He mentioned that he knows that this information has been sent and emailed to the school. The counselor at the school should also have the information.

NEVADA HEALTH CENTER

Nevada Health Center update.

Kerrie Preston (Nevada Health Center Practice Manager Jackpot and Wendover location) stated that the numbers for the previous year at the Jackpot Clinic were 336 patients seen by Skylar and Rachel Grant (Nurse-practitioner) who is in Jackpot every other month from Wendover. The previous month the clinic saw 12 patients, Rachel was at the clinic the day prior, and she saw 4 patients. Rachel is at the Jackpot clinic every other month for woman's health and can see anybody, but they are specifically setting some time aside to have a female provider present for woman's health. Mrs. Preston mentioned that the mammovan schedule has come out and the mammovan will be in Jackpot May 13th for sure and they are still working on the October date, it will either be the 29th or 30th. Once she receives that information, she will let the town know. She is waiting for some flyers that she can send to the receptionist in the Jackpot clinic to be posted there. This way everybody will know that the mammovan will be coming and they can get their appointment scheduled.
